

Readmission is a transfer of the persons, (nationals of the origin state, third country nationals or stateless persons) who have been found to be illegally entering into, staying and residing in the territory of the one of the contracting states of an agreement, by that state and admission by the origin state.

Readmission agreements concluded by the Republic of Azerbaijan:

- Agreement between the Republic of Azerbaijan and the European Union on the readmission of persons residing without authorization (signed in Brussels on February 28, 2014, came into force on September 1, 2014);
- Agreement between the Government of the Republic of Azerbaijan and the Kingdom of Norway on the readmission of persons residing without authorization (signed in Baku on December 3, 2014, came into force on June 1, 2015);
- Agreement between the Government of the Republic of Azerbaijan and the Federal Council of Switzerland on the readmission of persons residing without authorization (signed in Bern on October 10, 2016, came into force on April 1, 2017);
- Agreement between the Government of the Republic of Azerbaijan and the Government of Montenegro on the readmission of persons residing without authorization (signed in Podgorica on April 27, 2017, came into force on December 15, 2017).

Reintegration:

- According to the assignment of the Cabinet of Ministers of the Republic of Azerbaijan dated December 28, 2016 No. 17/5425-22, Working Group on Reintegration was established with the purpose of application of comprehensive approach to the readmission process of citizens of the Republic of Azerbaijan residing in uncertain situation in the territory of foreign states based on readmission agreements, flexible solution of challenges and problems faced by the readmitted persons, as well as effective organization of reintegration of the abovementioned persons to the society.
- The State Migration Service jointly implements “Reintegration support to Azerbaijani returnees (RESTART)” project with the International Center for Migration Policy Development (ICMPD).
